WHAT IS TRAVEL INSTRUCTION?

The DCTMA's Travel Instruction program was developed with the assistance of Easter Seals Project ACTION. The goal of the program is to assist case workers, professional staff, and caregivers in becoming familiar with the options for fixed route public transportation in order to better serve your clients with physical and cognitive disabilities. This program will provide you with valuable information to better serve your client's needs for transportation and will assist you with helping clients live within their community and access all it has to offer.

The program includes valuable information about how to:

- Plan a trip
- Access, read and explain transit schedules
- Get to a bus stop or train station
- Ride using mobility devices
- Pay the fare
- Determine eligibility to ride at a discount

We also include tips to be safe and enjoy the ride.

The training is conducted in a 45-minute presentation, although we can work with you to design a more in-depth program to meet your needs. Additional training opportunities include hands-on experience with an on-site SEPTA bus and operator, and a supervised field trip to role play using your newly-learned skills.



WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF TRAVEL INSTRUCTION?

Travel instruction can help people make the transition from private automobiles to using public transportation, increasing their mobility and access to jobs and volunteer activities, as well as provide additional opportunities for social interaction and recreation.
