Municipalities Conference & Trade Show

The Delaware County Transportation Management Association welcomed Jim Ritzman, PennDOT Deputy Secretary of Planning, as the keynote speaker of the 16th Annual Municipalities Conference & Trade Show: Integrating Transportation Demand Strategies, held April 12, 2018 at Drexelbrook Corporate Events Center in Drexel Hill, PA.

All 49 municipalities in Delaware County were invited to the event. More than 200 municipal managers, elected officials, engineers, road and highway managers, maintenance crews, emergency services personnel, plus environmental, zoning and planning committee members had the opportunity to network and exchange ideas for improving the county's transportation infrastructure.

This year featured two break-out sessions - "Advanced Signal Technologies: What's Working, What's New?" featuring Silvia Scheuermann, PE, Traffic Engineer, Urban Engineers, Inc. and Michael Centi, Traffic Control Specialist, PennDOT. In addition, the LTAP presentation, "Watch Where You Walk: Crosswalk Standards and the ADA," was led by Mark M. Hood, PE, Senior Engineer, Pennoni.

Dozens of vendors were on hand featuring products and services helpful to the attending municipalities and businesses. Exhibitors included engineering companies, financial firms, planning organizations, and transportation businesses.

Also featured, our Community Traffic Safety Program. "Can You Walk the Line?" Participants got a firsthand look at how dangerous impaired driving can be, by wearing the Fatal Vision Goggles, and walking the police line.

High School Seatbelt Challenge

Sun Valley High School, based in Aston, won DCTMA's 10th Annual High School Seat Belt Challenge. The student drivers showed the highest increase in seat belt usage this year by 12% between the fall and spring semesters. DCTMA presented the school's Student Senate members a \$500 check and special plaque to hang in the school over the next year.



Engineering Scholarship

During the Municipalities Conference, the DCTMA Engineering Committee awarded the 3rd Annual Engineering Scholarship to Myrlie Taylor, a freshman studying Civil Engineering at **Delaware County Community College**. The committee reviewed applicants' essays and transcripts, and felt the Upper Darby teen was most deserving of the \$1,000 scholarship, given her perfect 4.0 GPA and career goals in engineering.

SEPTA Key

The SEPTA Key rollout is in full swing, and the DCTMA is ensuring all public transportation commuters are on board. We've held events throughout Delaware County, signing up thousands of riders for the new payment technology.



Transportation Enhancement Grant

In line with our Transportation Demand Management mission of promoting alternative transportation, mitigating congestion, and reducing emissions, DCTMA offers an Annual Transportation Enhancement Grant. In 2017, we awarded **Penn State Brandywine** \$1,000 for the installation of new, secure bicycle parking across the campus. Other Enhancement Grant projects may include safe bus shelters, coordinating a carpool program, or creating accessible crosswalks. DCTMA's grant is open to all member companies and municipalities in Delaware County.
